Pool Tags

Pool tags will be issued the first day the pool is open, as well as the following week.

If you are a new resident that moved in after the pool tags have been issued, you can contact the HOA if you did not have one mailed to you shortly after you moved in.

Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations, for the safe and sanitary operation of the pool, are for your protection and benefit.

- Two tags are issued to each home. Pool tags are required for entry into the facility, 2 guests per tag are allowed.
- No entry to the pool is permitted after hours. Violators will be subject to trespass laws.
- The pool gate must be closed at all times.
- No glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed within fenced pool area.
- No smoking at any time.
- No diving.
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller skates, or in-line skates in pool area.
- Individuals with infections or bandages are not permitted in the pool.
- Private parties by permit only.
- Only small floating items are allowed in the pool and subject to pool manager's discretion.
- No running or excessive horseplay.
- Babies in diapers not allowed in pool. Swim diapers allowed.
- No food, drinks or gum allowed in pool.
- No pets are permitted on the pool premises.
- No pushing or throwing of people into the pool.
- Proper swimming attire required (no cutoffs or street clothes).
- There will be a ten minute rest period per hour.
- Cocoa butter, baby oil and other heavy oils and lotions are not permitted due to potential equipment damage.
- Members are responsible for the action of their guests.
- All children under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult not under the age of 18 years of age.
- No swimming after designated hours unless special arrangements have been made.
- No excessive noise or music.
- No plug-in electrical appliances are allowed in pool area.
- Lifeguards are employees for the safety of the members and their guests. They have full authority to enforce any and all pool rules and to suspend violators' privileges.

- All non-swimmers must be within parent/guardian's arms reach at all times. **No exceptions.**
