## MEMBER RESOLUTION

Garage, yard and similar type sales conducted from Lots in Stonehenge constitute offensive activities and may be or may become annoyances and nuisances to the residents and Owners of Lots in Stonehenge in violation of Section 5 of Article VII of the "Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, Stonehenge" (the "Declaration"). The Board of Directors of the Association should take all actions allowed by the Declaration, Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Association to prohibit or enjoin Residents and Owners of Lots in Stonehenge from conduction of such sales on individual lots. Henceforward, the Clubbouse Complex will be dedicated two weekends per year for a subdivision garage sale under the auspices and direction of the Board of Directors for those Residents/Owners desiring to participate.
